The Black squares are done in a P2P so you can connect them all....

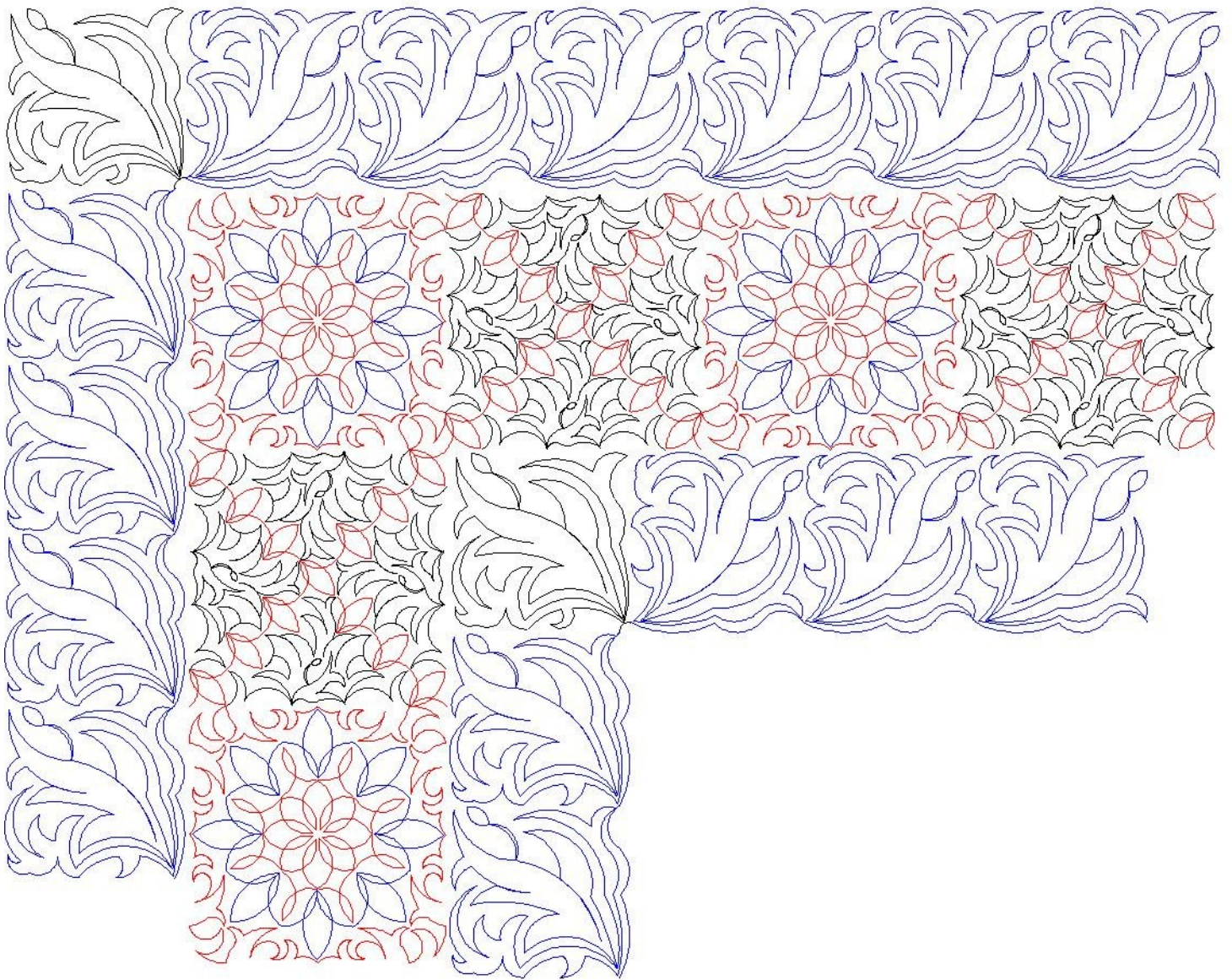
The outside edge pieces can be done P2P or can be connected in the points because of fabric shift I think I would do a bobbin pull up every so often so you can readjust if needed



Layout of Borders

The outer and inner 3 borders are combined to make a 5 inch border

So the borders are 5, 7, and 5

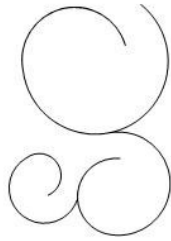


These patterns were created for Annette Ornelas' quilt called Forever Yours

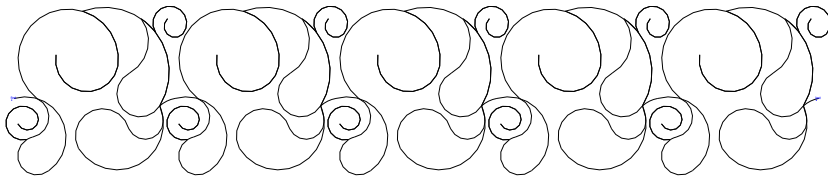


There are 2 different melon blks included in this set to accommodate 2 different opening sizes



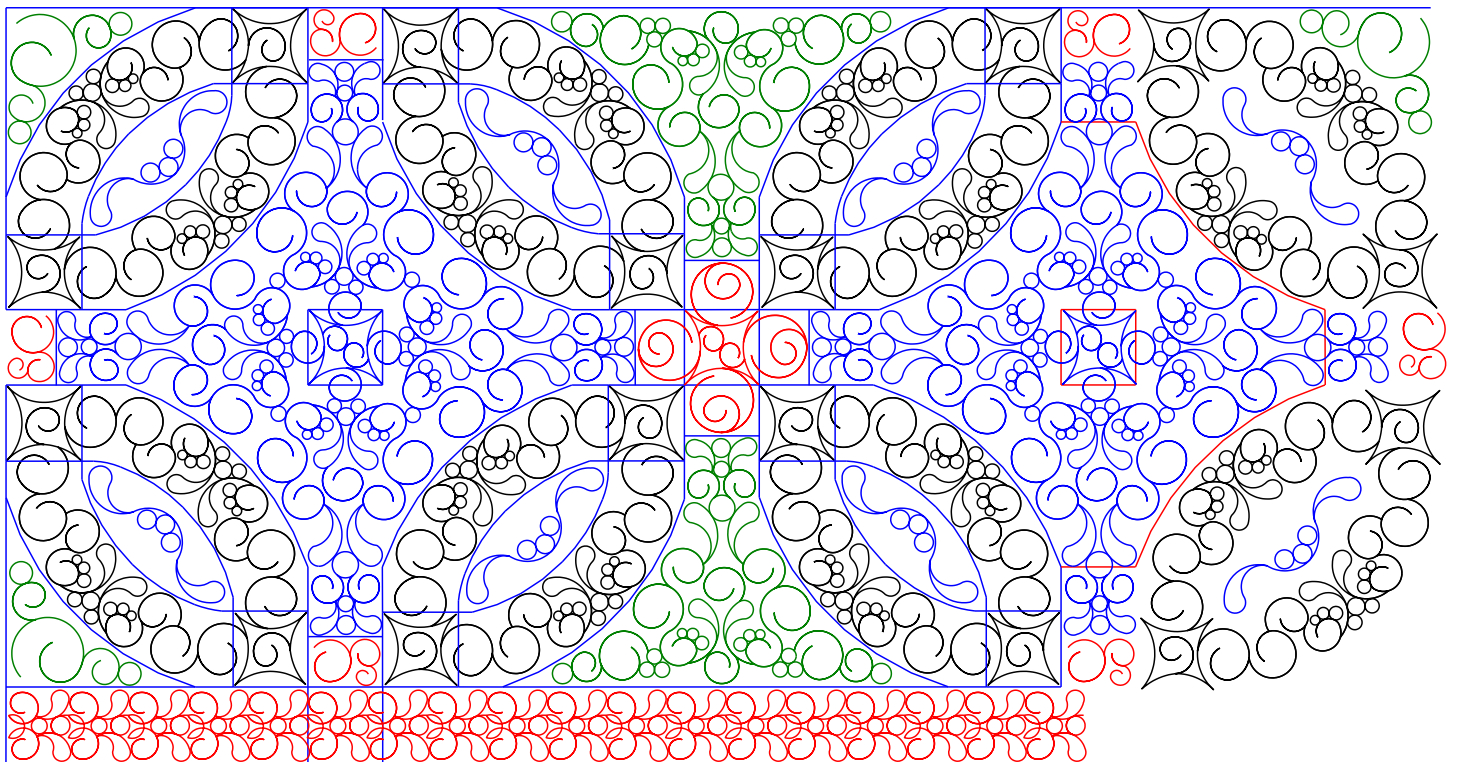
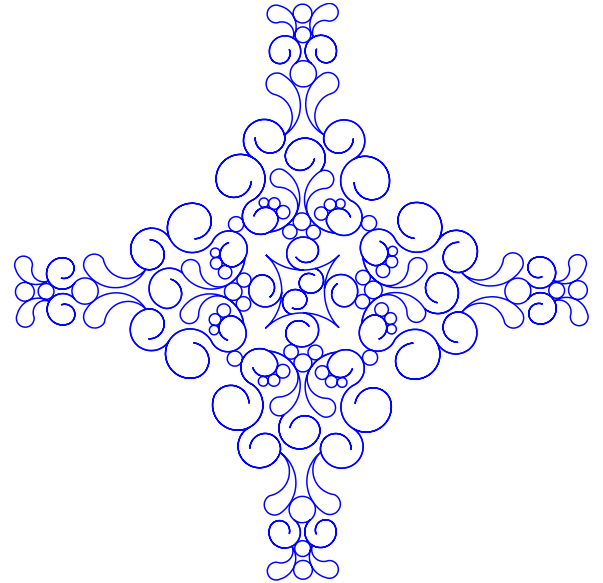
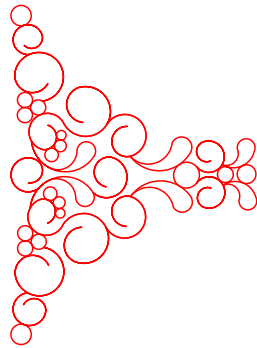
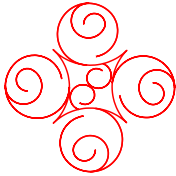
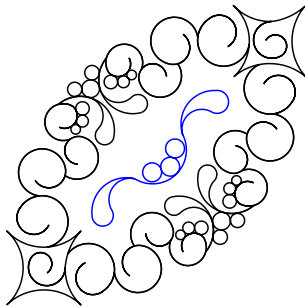
