






This months theme for E2E is Modern quilting For instruction on how to use these patterns contact your different machine instructors. I believe you can use these on any machine.

Statler Users instructions are on the page 10.




Modern Diamond curve E2E




Nodern Diamonds E2E









Modern Chevron Variation E2E the rows are 1 inch then 2 inches apart see layouts









Bee 2 Bdr Less detail for a smaller Border







Bee and beehive MMBdr










Bee MM 4 Bdr


Trapezoid 2 will fit trapezoid with a 10 base and a 3 inch width and 5 inches across top






Contessa by "Wing and a Prayer"

This is a layout of the borders using the patterns on the previous pages




"Contessa" King Quilt center this is showing the layout of the quilt without the applique work. With the applique you would eliminate odd blk 3 and hand quide around



Using the fill inside feature the computer will calculate how wide to make the pattern depending on the selected area. Try setting this up and playing with it a little before you start to quilt.

glass modern E2E— Modern quilting is on the run... with this pattern you can quilt all the way across the quilt with no over stitching—this pattern is 90 inches wide. You can use it on any size quilt. Layout the pattern in repeat patterns to cover the length of your quilt. Do not adjust the patterns unless you want it further apart or closer together. Define you quilt area, right click, and use fill inside. It will fill inside the defined area and will be ready to quilt. These instructions are for Statler Users. Other machine users consult




Use Repeat patterns the length of the quilt











Modern Chevron 2 E2E

is 2 inches apart




Modern Chevron Variation E2E




Modern Diamond curve E2E layout




Modern Diamond E2E (no tail)






