


Circles all around

Circle fun and Blow bubbles is the same pattern the name was changed later.






Square pegs in a Round hole E2E




Round pegs in a Square hole E2E








These patterns are part of a set for the guilt called, New York Wheel, by Ink Lingo, guilting patterns designed by Nancy Haacke

These borders are not repeatable automatically. There are several lengths of the two borders you need to determine your length and lay them in manually. I did this so you do not get any overstitching at the bottom of the border or sash. Use the longest one as much as you can then determine which one you need to finish out the border or sash see layout on following page to see how the corners go together... I think this is actually easier especially on those wonky borders. The difference between the two sets is the distance between each circle.












