

Instructions for your Download Library on you Wasatch Quilting Account

Login to your Wasatch Quilting Account

By clicking on Login

And filling out the information

Once you login click on, my profile on the upper right on the page

Under Account options;

Click on Download library

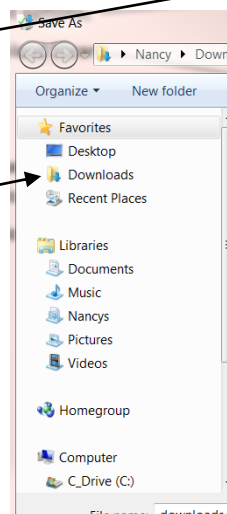
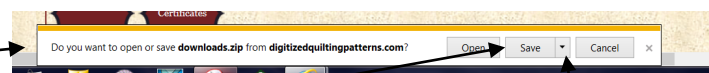
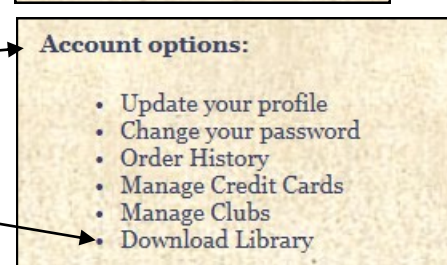
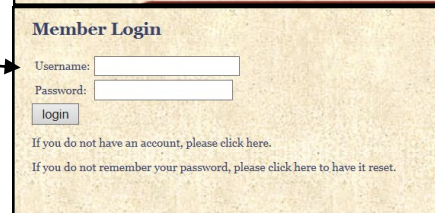
Put a check mark on the products you wish to download

And click on download selected

A pop up box will pop up

Click on the down arrow next to the save

Then click on **save as** it will give you three options save, save as or save and open, if you click on save, or save and open, it will go to this area on your computer. (Downloads). The best way is to click on save as, and choose where you want to put it.



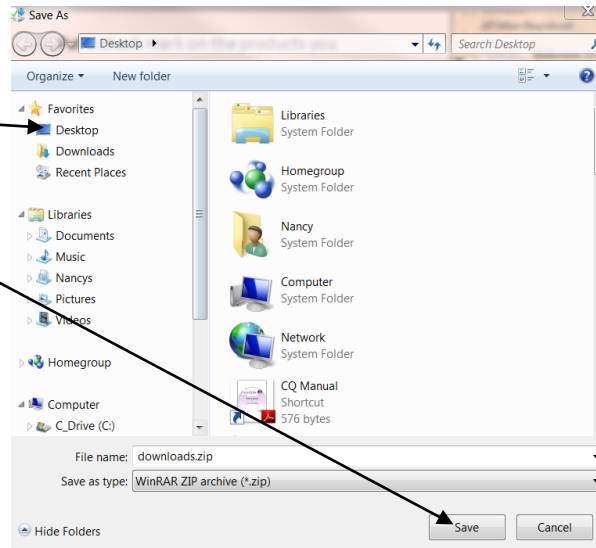
After clicking on the down arrow you should see this

Make sure you click on the down arrow

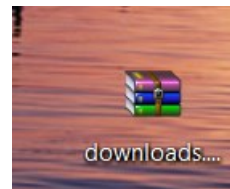
- Save

After you click on save as this box will pop up I always click on Desk top then on save

After you click on save the next box pops up at the bottom of your screen

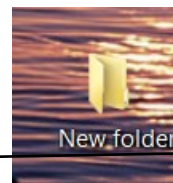


Click out of everything go to your desktop and you will a file that looks like this

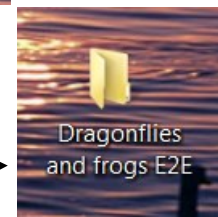


Drag and drop

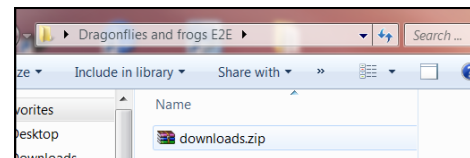
On your desk top right click and choose new, then folder, a new folder will then appear



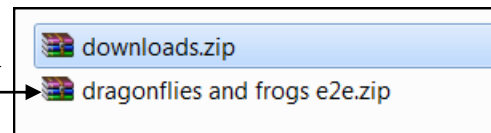
Right click on the folder and choose rename, and rename it to what your new pattern is



Now drag and drop your zipped downloads folder into the newly named folder. Now when you open that folder this is what it will look like

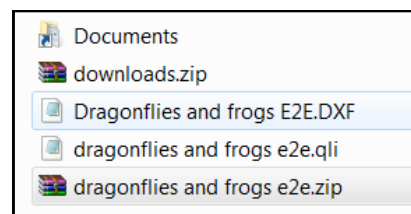


Right click on the zipped download folder and click on extract here this is what you will get



Now right click on the named pattern folder and click on, extract here, again, and this is what you will get.

Your patterns are extracted and ready to transfer to your quilting computer and use.



Note; if you try to take a zipped file to your quilting computer you will either get a blank file or a bunch of jibberish, that is the first sign that they did not unzip properly...
