



mentioned that we would have some changes in 2014, a couple of them are in the works we would like to tell you about...


- There is a new section on the top left of the main page of the web site. It is a category for all new patterns that have been put on the site in the last 60 days we are still tweaking this, but take a look and give us your input.
- We are adding a library section this section will contain all updates to patterns there have been when you login to the site if you have purchased a pattern the site

will keep track an allow you to download any new update there has been to that pattern. This change is almost ready.
